



Appendix for METRANS Krems to General Conditions for container transports in 2024

1. Further regulations, surcharges and additional services:

1.1. Surcharge for dangerous goods (incl. under limited quantity, limited quantity and uncleaned empty containers) in addition to transport tariff price:

- Class I and tank containers with dangerous goods of class II – VI a VIII – IX will be calculated individually.
- Dangerous goods of class II – VI and VIII – IX packed in pieces in box containers will be calculated individually.
- Class VII**excluded from transport**

We would like to inform you that it is not possible to transport the below-mentioned class of dangerous:

- Class 1, Compatibility Group A: UN-Numbers 0074,0113, 0114, 0129, 0130, 0135, 0224 to 0473
- Class I not possible with exception of UN 0334, 0335 and 0336
- Class 2 transport (UN 1017) of chlorine or transport of other stuffs containing chlorine not possible
- Class 4.1 Flammable Solids with Temperature Monitoring: UN-Numbers 3231 to 3240
- Class 5.2 Organic Peroxide with Temperature Monitoring: UN-Numbers 3111 to 3120
- Class 8 Sulfur trioxide with a purity of 99,95 %, which is transported without inhibitors (additive) in tank containers: UN-Nummer 1829

If exceptions or special permits etc. apply, any diversion from applicable laws is to be noted and a copy of any relevant document to be included with the transport.

Storage of dangerous goods on terminal METRANS Krems is excluded.

1.2. The price for transports of containers within Austria heavier than the usual weight categories is given individually. According to the decision of Austrian Parliament (as amended by BGBl.I No. 90/2013-Kraftfahrgesetz 1967 §4 section 7a), the maximum gross weight for all type of containers is 40 tons including chassi.

Transport of containers heavier than the maximum gross weight, i.e. with the weight above 26 tons (cargo + tara) is possible only after a previous agreement and the conditions are agreed individually.

Appendix for LINZ to General Conditions for container transports in 2024

1. The prices include:

- 1.1. The CY prices (up to terminal only or vice versa) include 1x handling (terminal – wagon or vice versa) at CCT Linz. The terminal – truck (or vice versa) handling is invoiced by CCT Linz. The all-in prices (including truck delivery) include 2x handling at CCT Linz.

2. Further regulations, surcharges and additional services:

- 2.1. Surcharge for dangerous goods (incl. under limited quantity, limited quantity and uncleaned empty containers) in addition to transport tariff price:
- Class I and tank containers with dangerous goods of class II – VI a VIII – IX will be calculated individually.
 - Dangerous goods of class II – VI and VIII – IX packed in pieces in box containers will be calculated individually.
 - Class VII.....**excluded from transport**
- If exceptions or special permits etc. apply, any diversion from applicable laws is to be noted and a copy of any relevant document to be included with the transport.
- 2.2. Storage of containers in import as well as export direction at CCT Linz
- Empty containers: in total 3 days free
from 4th day**EUR 1,86 / TEU / day**
 - Full containers: in total 3 days free
from 4th day till 7th day**EUR 2,65 / TEU / day**
from 8th day**EUR 5,30 / TEU / day**
- Storage of dangerous goods on CCT Linz is excluded**
- 2.3. Weighing of containers
- Weighing in accordance with SOLAS guidelines including weighing document (advance notification required)
.....**EUR 63,40**
 - Weighing after arrival at the terminal without prior notification.....**EUR 102,20**
- 2.4. Transports by truck over 29t gross (including container tare) are possible only after previous agreement. Surcharge for truck transports over 29t gross will be calculated individually.
- 2.5. The costs of vain rides are calculated individually.
- 2.6. Prices for deliveries to more places within one municipality will be calculated individually.
- 2.7. In case of CY transport (up to terminal only or vice versa), every additional cost or surcharge such as storage or VGM, will be invoiced by CCT Linz. In case of all in transport (including truck delivery), every additional cost or surcharge such as storage or VGM, will be invoiced by METRANS. Any additional costs, surcharges or fees incurred at CCT Linz will only be invoiced once a month after receipt of the monthly statement from CCT Linz to METRANS.

Appendix for Service via CTS Salzburg to General Conditions for container transports in 2024

1. Further regulations, surcharges and additional services:

- 1.1. EES – Energy Emergency Surcharge (fee from CTS Salzburg)**EUR 0,75/HUB**
(can be updated during the year, latest rate always published [here](#))
- 1.2. *Austria via Salzburg Fuel Surcharge* for trucking via CTS Salzburg to final destination can be found on [Energy Surcharge - METRANS](#)
- 1.3. *Surcharge for an additional truck transport* between train arrival/departure terminals and other terminal within port of Hamburg or Bremerhaven can be found in METRANS General Conditions 2024, Attachment Nr.2 and corresponding *Port Terminals Fuel Surcharge* on [Energy Surcharge - METRANS](#)
- 1.4. Surcharge for dangerous goods (incl. under limited and limited quantity and uncleaned empty containers) to combined transport tariff price:
Dangerous goods of class 2 – 6 and 8 – 9.....**EUR 75,-**
- 1.5. For each container with dangerous cargo leaving CTS Salzburg terminal by truck there must be done a check with CTS safety advisor and there's counted a surcharge for that.....**EUR 68,50**
- 1.6. Storage:
 - 1.6.1. Storage at CTS Salzburg terminal
empty container **only arrival day free**
full container **two days free (arrival and departure day)**
 - 1.6.2. Temporary storage at METRANS Prague terminal..... **12 days free (harmless cargo)**
- 1.7. Transports by truck via CTS Salzburg are limited with maximal weight 26 t incl. container tara; possibility and conditions for heavier containers upon request.
- 1.8. Weighing of containers (declaring total container weight VGM for purpose of SOLAS maritime convention)
 - 1.8.1. weighing at CTS Salzburg terminal (request for weighing of container must be placed at placing the transport order itself) – **EUR 67,50/container** (price includes weighing, issuing the certificate and sending the scanned copy of certificate to e-mail)
 - 1.8.2. weighing at METRANS Prague terminal (for routing from Salzburg to seaport via Prague, excluded for direct trains) – **EUR 45,-/container** (price includes weighing, issuing the certificate and sending the scanned copy of certificate to e-mail)
- 1.9. Operation of the CTS Salzburg terminal is regulated with own General conditions of CTS Salzburg 2024, there can be found other regulations and surcharges:

- 1.10. Re-invoicing of eventually occurring additional costs, surcharges and fees in unchanged amount takes place once in a month only, after receipt of monthly statement from CTS Salzburg to METRANS.
- 1.11. Export train has closing at 17:45 on day before departure from CTS Salzburg (departure days Tue-Sat early morning).
- 1.12. If the cancellation of the train transport is made after 15:00 on the working day preceding the day of the train closing, the Customer will be charged with cancellation cost of EUR 100,-/TEU.
